

The Warren Trust Awards for Architectural Writing

The New Zealand Institute of Architects invites entries into a new essay writing competition.

An award will be made in two categories: Open (architecture practitioners, tertiary students, and members of the public); and Secondary School Students (all years).

Essay Topic

Select a building or urban space you have enjoyed being in. What do you like about the building or place, for example, its design or layout, the way it relates to its setting, and the materials it is made from? Why do you think the building or space works so well?

Word Limits

1500 words *Open*
1000 words *Secondary*

Entry Criteria

An essay must address the set topic, must be wholly the work of the person submitting it, and must not have been published previously.

Friday 14 August 2015
